Student's Right to Cancel

Refund Policy/Calculation:

Notice of cancellation must be in writing, and a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.

(a) If notice of cancellation is made by the 1st class session, or the 7th class day after enrollment, whichever is later, GEOS

shall refund 100% of the amount paid for institutional charges, less the registration fee and/or other non-refundable fees as outlined in the school catalogue and enrollment agreement.

(b) Students who have completed 60% or less of the period of attendance shall receive a pro rata refund (total tuition, divided by

the number of days in the program, minus the number of days attended). There is no refund for students who have completed

61% or more of the period of attendance.

(c) All refunds will be made within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.

*GEOS is not obligated to make any refunds to students who are dropped administratively due to the violation of its written disciplinary and/or attendance policies or local, state or federal law.
